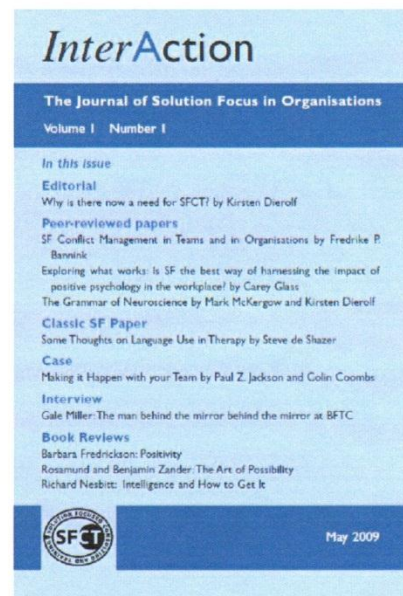
## InterAction journal student subscription scheme
